The alarm monitors both the mains voltage and the battery voltage and will alert the operator with an audible and visual alarm should either voltage drop below preset limits, indicating that either the battery has become disconnected or the mains power has failed.

This system can also be fitted to the civilian version of the charger used in trailer loading bays, as well as the existing 'traffic light' option.

This will ensure that appropriate steps can be taken by the vehicle operator to ensure that the batteries are always fully charged and ready for use.
